Compañeros Respite Ministry

National United Methodist Church is now offering shelter for “compañeros” or “companions/friends” who have been bused to Washington DC from Texas. Asylum seekers fleeing places like Venezuela, Cuba, and Nicaragua entered the United States at the southern border and are now caught in a state-to-state fight over immigration policy. Area churches like Capitol Hill UMC and Luther Place have been working closely with DC Mutual Aid Society since late April, scrambling to offer humanitarian aid and emergency housing. In September, emergency housing in the Saint Luke’s Mission Center was authorized by the NUMC Board of Trustees and Council allowing the church to receive six compañeros for short term respite housing as they choose their next steps for survival.
